GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that one FIR No.108 dated 15.06.2019 under Sections 302/201/34 IPC, Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib came to be lodged against some unknown persons but somehow the police suspects that the petitioner's husband is involved, although there is no credible evidence to suggest his involvement in any manner. It has been submitted that in order to pressurize the petitioner's husband, the police is now unnecessarily harassing the petitioner by raiding her house time and again so as to exert pressure upon her to produce her husband.

2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without making any expression as regards the alleged involvement of the petitioner's husband in any manner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib to ensure that in case the petitioner is required to be associated with any inquiry or investigation or some information is to be elicited from her, then a written advance notice in terms of Section 160 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 be served upon her and that due care and caution is taken in every regard keeping in view that petitioner is a lady.
3. A copy of this order be sent to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
