The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.357 dated 10.11.2015 under Sections 307/34 IPC (Sections 195, 353, 186, 182, 211, 120-B IPC were added later on) and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Sirsa, District Sirsa.

On 12.07.2019, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted regular bail and is facing the trial, however, on account of noting a wrong date as 31.05.2019 instead of 21.05.2019, he could not attend the Court on 21.05.2019 and therefore, his bail/surety bonds were cancelled and nonbailable warrants were issued. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and apply for fresh bail.

Notice of motion for 08.08.2019.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and the trial Court will release him on interim bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds. However, this

will be subject to payment of costs of Rs.3,000/- to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, concerned.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 12.07.2019, has already appeared before the trial Court and he has been released on interim bail. Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record copy of order dated 20.07.2019 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge along with receipt of payment of cost.

Learned counsel for the State has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 12.07.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
