The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 26.9.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 24673 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of by giving directions to the respondents/ authorities to look into the representation (Annexure P-11) and decide the same within a period of 6 months from the date of receipt of this order.”

Learned counsel for the State has produced copy of order dated 29.8.2019 whereby claim of the petitioner has been rejected. Copy thereof handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, liberty is sought to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order passed.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
