Pursuant to the order dated 22.08.2019, learned State counsel has produced in court today the custody certificate regarding the custody of the petitioner, showing him to have been in custody for 11 months and 22 days as of today.

She further submits, on instructions, that the trial is still to begin, with the charge still to be framed on October 10, 2019.

Consequently, without making any comment whatsoever on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, simply seeing the period of his custody, as also the fact that there is no other criminal case shown to be registered against him, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court.
