Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in a case FIR No.56 dated 19.04.2018, registered at Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar, under Sections 307, 323 and 34 of the IPC and Section 325 of the IPC added later on.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has brought to the notice of this Court that both the injured while appearing before the trial Court, have specifically stated that present petitioner, Amritpal Singh, was

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neither present at the time of occurrence nor had caused any injury to them.

The petitioner is in custody since 23.04.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
