AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 6.12.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 30858 of 2018. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“Without expressing any opinion on the merits of this case, this petition is being disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to pass appropriate order on the legal notice dated 25.7.2018 (Annexure P-10) within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

As per the order quoted above, the respondents had to take a decision on the legal notice within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order.

There is nothing on record to show that certified copy of the order has been supplied to the respondent. Let atleast now certified copy be

supplied to the respondents and in case of doing the needful, the

respondents shall ensure compliance of the order dated 6.12.2018 within four months from the receipt of certified copy of this order. In case of non-compliance, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable from the defaulting official.

With the aforesaid observation, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
