Petitioner has filed the instant petition voicing an apprehension and threat to her life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 12.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without going into merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No.3 i.e. SHO PS Sudhar, District Ludhiana, confined to the aspect of the threat that she perceives to her life at the hands of private respondents.

In the eventuality of any application being moved by the petitioner, respondent No.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
