Petitioner had sought a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents authorities to transfer the enquiry that had been initiated against the petitioner pursuant to an anonymous application dated 28.06.2019 (Annexure P-2) which had been moved on behalf of lady staff working in the Office of The Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Faridkot.

On behalf of the petitioner it had been contended that the enquiry has been marked to an official against whom the petitioner had sought information under the provisions of Right to Information Act and who as such is biased against him.

Mr. APS Gill, AAG, Punjab, upon instructions from Mr. Sukhminder Pal Singh, Sr. Assistant, RTA Faridkot, apprises the Court that after filing of the writ petition the enquiry proceedings has since been transferred and have now been marked to a different Officer i.e. SDM

Jaitu, District Faridkot.

In the light of such development, no further directions are required to be passed in the petition and the same is disposed of as infructuous.
