ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)

This is 2nd petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No.184 dated 29.08.2018 under Sections 452, 323, 34 IPC and Sections 459 & 325 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda, earlier was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 23.05.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this second petition has been filed in view of the fact that the petitioner has undergone 10 months of custody and the charges have already been framed. It is further submitted that the petitioner along with co-accused Talwinder Singh @ Bhinder Singh has earlier filed a petition praying for grant of regular bail in the aforesaid FIR under Sections 452, 323, 34 IPC and Sections 459 & 325 IPC were added later

on. Learned counsel further submits that investigation is complete, charges have been framed and no prosecution witnesses has been examined so far.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of custody certificate and on instructions from SI Ganeshwar Singh, has not disputed the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 06.09.2018 and is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
