Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the provident fund contribution, made by the late husband of the petitioner from 01.01.2005 till 31.07.2012, for which the petitioner is entitled for, has not been released to her so far despite the fact that Sh. Balwinder Singh, who had retired on 31.07.2012 and thereafter, unfortunately died.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has submitted a representation Annexure P-5 to the Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarter, Sector 9 Chandigarh on 15.02.2019, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 15.02.2019 (Annexure P-5), the present writ

petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 15.02.2019 (Annexure P-5) within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the representation, the same should also be paid to her within three months thereafter.
