The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 64 dated 13.04.2019, registered under Sections 341, 324, 148, 149 (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Vide order dated 12.07.2019, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail noticing the fact that the injury invoking Section 326 IPC is attributed to co-accused Yogesh @ Jogi and there is a delay of 04 days in registration of the FIR.

Since the Bar is on strike for the last about twelve days and there is no representation on either of the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 12.07.2019, is made absolute subject to the condition that if the petitioner is required for further investigation, he will appear before the Investigating Officer on the notice given by him and the petitioner will also abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it is made clear that in case the petitioner is found misusing the concession of anticipatory bail, it will be open for the prosecution/complainant to apply for recalling of the order.
