The claim of the petitioner in the present writ petition is for the grant of revise pension and pensionary benefits after granting him the benefit of service rendered from 10.05.1977 till 18.12.1991 as a qualifying service.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that respondent-department has already allowed the claim of the petitioner for taking into consideration the service rendered by the petitioner from 10.05.1977 till 18.12.1991 as a qualifying service and has already re-computed the benefits for which the petitioner becomes entitle.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that the revised gratuity amounting to ₹1,72,937/- will be released to the petitioner within a

period of one week and the arrears of the revised pension will be released to the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present writ petition, hence the petitioner does not wish to press this writ petition any further.
