JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the respondents to regularize the marriage palace of the petitioner, as he has constructed the same in the year 1999 after depositing the requisite fee and getting necessary approval from the respondents.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that at this stage, she would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No. 2-Senior Town and Country Planner, Municipal Council, Amritsar to consider and decide the representation dated 12.3.2018 (Annexure P-9) expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl.AG, Punjab accepts notices on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete set of paper book has been supplied to him in the Court.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Town and Country Planner, Municipal Council, Amritsar to consider and decide the representation dated 12.3.2018 (Annexure P-9) within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
