TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner seeks a mandamus for directing the officials respondents to take necessary steps to protect his life and liberty by voicing an apprehension to the same at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 11.

Counsel submits that one Gurdev Singh had instituted a civil suit seeking permanent injunction with regard to immovable property and in which the petitioner was arrayed as a party defendant. In such civil suit, an application under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC had been filed and even an interim injunction had been granted. Further contended that the private respondents herein in connivance with the plaintiff/Gurdev Singh have violated the status quo order and even sold the property. Contempt proceedings are also stated to have been initiated and which are pending before the competent Court.

Prayer has been made to direct the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur/respondent No.4 to take action on a representation that has been preferred against the private respondents for having violated a status quo order.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length and the writ paper book has been perused.

Insofar as the grant of ad interim injunction and violation thereof is concerned, petitioner has already resorted to his remedy of having filed a contempt petition and which is pending. There would be no occasion for this Court to direct the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into such matter.

As regards seeking protection is concerned, pleadings on record are completely silent with regard to the threat perception and any immediate danger to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

No intervention in the matter as such is called for.

Petition is dismissed.
