[1] After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file a fresh writ petition in order to maintain a challenge to the decision of the respondents to permit only those candidates, who had appeared between the year 2001 to 2018 in Class 10 & 12 examination to appear for improvement of their score, while depriving candidates, who had done their Class 10 & 12 in earlier years.
