The petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondent No.6 to continue providing proper supply of milk products for route No.333, 343 and 353 which were allotted to the petitioner.

The petitioner, a distributor of milk products of respondent No.2, is aggrieved against the reduced supply of milk on the routes allotted to it, i.e. routes No. 343-Hodal and Hassanpur, 353-Mathura and Varindawan and 333-Palwal City and Hodal without giving any show cause notice.

On the other hand, it is contended that as per clause 4 of the revised terms and conditions, the respondents reserved the right to appoint more distributors in the area allotted to the petitioner at any time without assigning any reason. The petitioner has been allowed

only route No.333 (Palwal City to Hodal). Route No. 343 and 353 were never allotted to the petitioner as is clear from the letter of appointment dated 15.02.2010 (Annexure P-1). As per revision in the policy of the Union and to increase the sale of Milk, it was decided to appoint more distributors in the jurisdiction of Milk Union, Ballabgarh by allotting the untapped area and by carving some areas from the existing distributors keeping the principle of contiguity. Accordingly, some of the area of the petitioner has been given to new distributor.

Heard.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has failed to show any *mala fide* on the part of the respondents in cancelling the route of the milk products. The new areas have been carved out keeping in view the principle of contiguity.

No ground for interference is made out.

Dismissed.
