The petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 140 dated 03.09.2018 registered under Section 22 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (**NDPS**) Act, 1985, at Police Station Sultanwind, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that 910 intoxicating tablets had been allegedly recovered from the petitioner and he was taken in custody on the same day i.e. 03.09.2018.

On the instructions from SI Punjab Rai, learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that till now out of 10 prosecution witnesses, only 1 witness has been partly examined.

Without commenting anything on the merits lest, it should prejudice the case either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
