Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that representations submitted by him to the Executive Engineer, Abohar Division, Abohar dated 06.07.2017 (Annexure P-4) and the Chief Engineer, Canals, Punjab Chandigarh, dated 02.05.2019 (Annexure P-5) are not being considered wherein he has projected his claim on the basis of the revenue record that earlier sanctioned Orchard in an area of 14 acres in the name of Surjit Singh and Basant Singh son of Modan Singh is not in existence for the last 25 years but the water is being supplied to these co-sharers. Referring to the record, he asserts that the land is no more being used as Orchard but it is used for the cultivation of paddy and wheat etc. In the absence of the Orchard, extra water which is being given to Surjit Singh and Basant Singh has to be distributed amongst other co-sharers of Mogha No.134/TCR, Jhorar Minor, Village and Post Officer Khane Ki Dhab, Ziledari Rupana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner at this stage would be satisfied if a direction be issued to respondents No.2-

Chief Engineer, Irrigation (Canals), Madhya Marg, 18-B, Sector 18, Chandigarh and respondent No.3 Executive Engineer, Abohar Canal Division, Abohar, District Fazilka, Punjab respectively to consider and decide the representations dated 02.05.2019 (Annexure P-5) and 06.07.2017 (Annexure P-4) within some specified time.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Chief Engineer, Irrigation (Canals), Madhya Marg, 18-B, Sector 18, Chandigarh and respondent No.3 Executive Engineer, Abohar Canal Division, Abohar, District Fazilka, Punjab respectively to consider and decide the representations dated 02.05.2019 (Annexure P-5) and 06.07.2019 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner to them preferably within a period of eight months. Decision so taken thereon, be conveyed to the petitioner.

Petition stands disposed of.
