Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 92, dated 04.09.2017, registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner is in custody since 04.09.2017 and he be allowed to withdraw the present petition for regular bail, but direction be issued to the learned trial Judge to conclude the trial in a time bound manner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, contended that trial is at the fag end as all the prosecution witnesses have been examined.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Judge to make strenuous effort to conclude the trial within a period of three months.
