Learned counsel for appearing for respondents No. 1 to 4, on instructions from Mr. Ashutosh, U.D.C, Estate Division, Ludhiana, submits that the case of the petitioner for grant of promotion would be considered in accordance with law, subject to the final outcome of the civil suit filed by him, wherein, he has challenged the irregular period of service of five months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that regardless of the abovesaid period of five months, the petitioner has rendered 19 years of unblemished service ever since i.e. w.e.f. 17.07.2000 and while his juniors have been granted promotion, his case has not been considered owing to the pendency of the civil suit.

In the premise, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent(s) to consider the case of the petitioner keeping in view the service record of the petitioner w.e.f. 17.07.2000 onwards and take a decision on his promotion w.e.f. the date when his juniors have been promoted, in accordance with law.

Let needful be done within a period of three months from today.
