[1] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 30.11.2018, speaking order was passed on 13.12.2018 wherein claim of the petitioner was found to be genuine. Copy of speaking order dated 13.12.2018 as furnished by learned counsel for the petitioner is taken on record as **Mark – 'A'**.

[2] Learned counsel states that in view of order Mark 'A', the respondents are required to grant retiral benefits to the petitioner in terms thereof as also interest on the same on account of delay which would result in release of retiral benefits in view of the decision of this Court in CWP No.16613 of 2012 in titled as Smt. Manjit Kaur vs State of Punjab and others decided on 04.11.2015.

[3] Learned Sr. Deputy Advocate General does not oppose the consideration of the claim of the petitioner for retiral benefits in terms of order Mark 'A' as well as interest thereon in terms of the decision of this Court in Smt. Manjit Kaur's case (Supra).

[4] In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to consider, and release the retiral benefits found due to the petitioner in terms of order Mark – ‘A’ dated 13.12.2018 along with interest, if any within 3 months from today in the light of decision of this Court in Smt. Manjit Kaur’s case (Supra).
