Petitioners, herein, seek grant of *ex-gratia*/solatium on account of their father having died in harness.

2. Per contra, the conceded stand of the respondent-PSPCL is that in case the petitioners submit the requisite documents for the purpose of solatium, the same would be disbursed to them as borne out from para 2 of the preliminary objections of the reply.

3. In the premise, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-PSPCL to disburse the solatium, as per the entitlement of the petitioners by treating the present writ petition as part of the requisite documents to be submitted by the petitioners alongwith the proof of the petitioners being the LRs of the deceased-employee i.e. Ram Avtar.

4. Let needful be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of furnishing the requisite information/documents by the petitioners.
