Grievance of the petitioner is that his services were regularized from the year 2007 as against his contended date of entitlement in the year 1985.

2. Despite representation dated 23.03.2018 (Annexure P-6), neither the petitioner has been granted any opportunity of being heard nor otherwise any reasons have been assigned for denying the benefit of regularization as claimed with effect from the contended date. Petitioner caused a legal notice dated 08.05.2018 (Annexure P-7) but to no avail. Then petitioner made a representation dated 19.03.2019 (Annexure P-8) but the same has also not been adverted to by the respondents till date. Hence, the writ petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of the petition, Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State.
5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.
6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 19.03.2019 (Annexure P-8) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.
7. Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
8. Disposed of in above terms.
