GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

Today at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to raise all the points raised herein before the trial Court at appropriate stage including his submission to the effect that in fact there was no *mala fide* intention on the part of the petitioners who happen to be LR's of Randhir Singh, to sell any land in excess of their holding and that in fact the land in the share of Randhir Singh i.e. predecessor-in-interest of the petitioners was being described as land measuring 58 'Kanals' in the revenue record since the year 1987 and when the said error had crept in the revenue record, petitioner No.2 was not even born and petitioner No.1 was merely 7 years

old and that they always remained under bonafide impression that their holding was 57-58 '*Kanals*'.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. The petitioners would be at liberty to make all the submissions as noticed above before the trial Court, which shall be duly looked into by the trial Court at the appropriate stage.
