This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 6.2.2019 passed in CWP No. 26731 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"Learned State counsel on instructions from Shashi, Law Officer, office of DPI (SE) Punjab, submits that the Secretary Education, Punjab, would consider the matter in light of orders dated October 30th, 2018 and September 13, 2018 (passed in connected case i.e. CWP-15922-2017) within six weeks and take necessary steps. In case, any adverse decision is taken, same shall be conveyed to the petitioners forthwith. The information received by the petitioners under the Right to Information Act has been handed over to learned State counsel. He submits that the same shall also be looked into.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is satisfied with the statement made by the State counsel.

Petition is, thus, disposed of."

Today an order dated 2.8.2019 has been placed on record. Copy supplied to counsel for the petitioner. The claim of petitioner has been rejected.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the claim of petitioner has wrongly been rejected by the respondents. He further submits that the merit list, list of candidates appointed and criteria of appointment have not been supplied.

Learned State counsel further submits that the same would be provided to the counsel for the petitioner within two weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law against the order dated 2.8.2019.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
