Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in a case FIR No.84 dated 04.04.2019, under Sections 22 and 25 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna, District Khanna. He is in custody since his arrest on 04.04.2019.

As per the case of the prosecution, on 04.04.2019, 95 injections of Avil and 95 injections of Rexogesic-2mls were recovered from the bag kept by the accused while they were found travelling on scooter No. PB-08Y-4881, which was being driven by accused Manjeet Singh on which accused Rahul Verma was pillion rider.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Sukhdeep Kaur, has apprised the Court that the petitioner is not only the owner of the two wheeler, but was driving the same when the above Narcotic substance was recovered from him. According to him, the charges have been framed recently on 18.09.2019 and it is pointed out that the recovered contraband falls in commercial quantity.

Considering the above, no ground is made out to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed.
