Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No.0066 dated 04.07.2017 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No.1, Pathankot, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel contends that the FIR was lodged by complainant, namely, Dr. Joginder Singh wherein he highlighted corruption in the registration office by indicting four officials, namely, Navtej Singh, Jaspal Singh, Dalbir Singh and Baljit Singh and quoted the instance of execution of a sale deed through impersonation by the petitioners. Learned counsel further contends that no such transaction took place and no sale deed was executed as alleged in the FIR. It is pointed out that during the pendency of the petition, final report stands filed on 04.02.2019 and charges have been framed by the trial Court. None of the officials of the registration office were challaned in the final report.

Since neither the final report is before this Court nor the order framing charges, therefore, it will not be appropriate for this Court to exercise the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.

However, it shall be open for the petitioners to raise this issue before the revisional Court by way of revision.
