Petitioner Rajesh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.1061 dated 29.08.2018, registered at Police Station City Karnal, District Karnal, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution case, Farzana impersonated as complainant-Sushma Rani Pahuja and took loan of ₹25 lakhs from the bank, by mortgaging land of the complainant in connivance with the bank official. The allegation against the present petitioner is mainly that he connived with Farzana and also got prepared a fake Aadhaar

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The petitioner has been in custody since 07.05.2019. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
