Learned State counsel submits that the present writ petition is rendered infructuous as the relief sought is that the date of birth of the petitioner be treated as 12.10.1957 instead of 09.09.1954 and he be allowed to continue in service till 31.10.2017. She submits that during pendency of the writ petition, the petitioner has attained the age of superannuation even if his date of birth is to be taken as 12.10.1957.

In view of the statement of learned State counsel, petition is dismissed as infructuous.

It is made clear that writ petition having become infructuous will not come in the way of the entitlement of the petitioner who seeks salary for the period he had actually worked which is stated to be from 30.09.2014 to 30.09.2015.

In the premise, respondent No.4 is directed to ascertain

in the event, petitioner had worked for the period as stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner then the salary for the said period be disbursed to him.

Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
