The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.20, dated 19.01.2019, under Sections 407 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Khedki Daula, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is alleged that the goods worth over ₹ 2 lacs were misappropriated from the truck. She further contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and is in custody for over six months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Sajjan Singh, states that the petitioner along with other co-accused has misappropriated the articles of the value of over ₹ 2 lacs. He further states that five out of fourteen prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over six months, he is not involved in any other case and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some

time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
