Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.489 dated 04.05.2019 under Sections 307, 323, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that a compromise is effected between the parties on 22.11.2019 and it is agreed that both the parties will file a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act for dissolution of the marriage by way of mutual consent in the 2nd week of May, 2020 at Jagadhri (Yamuna Nagar). It is also agreed that the petitioner will file a petition seeking quashing of the present FIR, on the basis of compromise. A photocopy of the compromise deed dated 22.11.2019 duly signed by both the

parties and attested by the witnesses is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

Learned counsel for the parties are also *ad idem* that in view of the above, the order dated 20.07.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, may be made absolute.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of. The order dated 20.07.2019 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute and the direction issued to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar to provide an additional PSO/Gunman to the complainant, shall remain operative till the time, the parties finally settle their dispute. In the meantime, the trial Court shall adjourn the case to await outcome of the quashing petition to be filed by the petitioner.

The parties shall remain bound by all the terms and conditions of the compromise deed dated 22.11.2019 (Mark 'A').

It will be open for the complainant to apply for cancellation of bail in case the petitioner is found misusing the concession of bail or extending threat to her or her family members.
