Having heard counsel for the petitioners at length and having perused the case paper book, this Court is of the considered view that no intervention in the matter is called for.

Petitioners have sought a mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

Further prayer is for issuance of directions to take appropriate action/initiate an enquiry against police officials i.e. respondents No. 3 and 7 for harassing the petitioners and at the behest of respondents No.4 to 6.

The averments made in the petition are utterly vague. This Court cannot draw any inference on the basis of the pleadings as regards any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

The prayer in the instant petition as such cannot be entertained.

Petition dismissed.
