The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of her arrest in FIR No.203 dated 08.10.2017 under Sections 363, 366-A and 120-B IPC (Section 376 IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 added later on) registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 16.07.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court and was admitted on bail by the trial Court. He further states that the petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court and to face the trial in accordance with law.
