Today, at the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and to apply for grant of regular bail with further liberty to raise all the pleas including his plea to the effect that the petitioner cannot be stated to have been in conscious possession of the contraband, which was allegedly recovered from the underneath driver seat.

In view of the aforesaid request, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and applies for grant of regular bail, the learned trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously preferably within a period of one week from filing of such application.
