This order will dispose of two writ petitions i.e. CWP No.15600 of 2017 and 27147 of 2017, wherein petitioners have made a prayer for mandamus to direct the respondents to fix their initial salary in terms of Rule 7.20 of Punjab Civil Service Rules Volume-II.

A reply has been filed on behalf of the State, according to which during the period of probation, petitioners would not be entitled to any grade pay, annual increments and other allowances. Learned State counsel, however, submits that detailed order shall be passed after considering provisions of Rule 7.20 of the Rules within three months.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary. Both the petitions are hereby disposed of.
