HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. .

In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the amount which the petitioner has spent on the treatment of his wife, is not being reimbursed by the respondent-State, though there is no impediment in the release of the medical reimbursement.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that before the reimbursement is done, certain documents are necessary for processing the case, but, in the present case, the petitioner has not submitted the required documents so as to become eligible for reimbursement of the medical bills.

Learned counsel for the respondents further states that in case, petitioner approaches the respondents and fulfils all the necessary requirement, the case of the petitioner for the reimbursement of medical bills will be considered and in case, after consideration, the petitioner is found entitled for

the reimbursement of the medical bills, appropriate orders will be passed granting the benefit to the petitioner.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the respondents to fulfil all the requirement for release of medical reimbursement.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
