This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the official respondents to vacate the pond of village Talwandi, Jasondha Singh and re-build the drainage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar, is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 11.05.2017 (Annexure P-4).

Learned State counsel submits that she has no objection if such a direction is issued.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar, to consider and decide the representation dated 11.05.2017 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate remedial measures to address the grievance of the petitioners in pursuance of the report dated 09.06.2017 (Annexure P-5) of Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Majitha (Amritsar) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
