On 12.07.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that father has registered FIR against her daughter and her friend alleging stealing away gold and cash amounting to ₹2,00,000/-. He has further submitted that the petitioner is not named in the FIR.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ramdeep Pratap Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 16.08.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner

has joined the investigation.

Since the correctness of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner is not contested by learned State counsel, therefore, the interim order dated 12.07.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
