1. Learned DAG has placed on record certificate issued by the Principal Govt. College, Bawal to the effect that 'No Dues Certificate' was not given to the petitioner as he had not deposited ₹41,266/- on account of missing books but since the petitioner had now deposited the said amount in Government Account on 05.07.2018, the college had issued No Dues Certificate and had also paid the amount due to the petitioner. Copy of the certificate along with documents in support thereto are taken on record. Copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that the writ petition be disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to submit a representation to the respondents for payment of interest qua the period of delay in making the payment of dues and the same be directed to be considered and decided.

2. Learned DAG on the other hand contends that the petitioner is not entitled to payment over and above that already paid.

3. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel for the parties.

4. In view of the amount on account of missing of books having been deposited and 'No Dues Certificate' having been issued to the petitioner, besides payment of amount due to him having been made, the writ petition no longer survives and is disposed of as having become infructuous.

5. As regards the claim for payment of interest on account of alleged delay in making payment, liberty is granted to the petitioner to make a representation in respect thereto and on receipt, the representation shall be considered and decided by the respondents, as per law.

6. Writ petition disposed of in aforementioned terms.
