The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 22.11.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 29608 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the claim being made by the petitioner in the present writ petition or in the legal notice dated 14.8.2018 (Annexure P-1), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 14.8.2018 (Annexure P-1) served by the petitioner by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.”

Short reply dated 27.9.2019 by way of affidavit of Dr. Balkar Singh, IAS, Director, Secondary Education, Haryana filed in court is taken on record, copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. With the reply, order dated 17.9.2019 has been annexed containing details of calculations.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the reply filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the calculations and the order passed.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
