Petitioner herein, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to issue him appointment to the post of Constable vide advertisement contained at Annexure P-1, which has been withheld on the ground that his Backward Class Certificate does not contain any date of issue. The petitioner also submitted representation dated 17.04.2019 (Annexure P-6), but the same has not been adverted to by the respondents. Hence the petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of petition, Mr. Ramesh Chand, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. A perusal of the information provided under Right to Information Act, as contained at Annexures P-4 and P-5, reveal that the decision to consider the application of the petitioner for appointment to the post of Constable in OBC category, is under process.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority/respondent to objectively consider the representation dated 17.04.2019 (Annexure P-6) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

8. Disposed of in above terms.
