Petitioner- Des Raj has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in complaint case No.39 of 2017 registered under Sections 3-4 (10) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (prevention of Atrocities) Act and Sections 307, 323 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, titled as “Pappu Vs. Suresh Kumar and another”.

It is not disputed that previously the petitioner had filed petition bearing No.CRM-M-28091-2019 for grant of pre-arrest bail in complaint case No.37. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner had not pressed the petition for grant of pre-arrest bail and vide order dated 08.07.2019, sought permission to withdraw the petition to enable his client/petitioner to surrender and avail the remedy under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that since the previous counsel was not instructed to withdraw the petition, therefore, the present petition has been filed, however, it is not disputed that the power of

attorney signed by the petitioner in favour of the Advocate contains the clause of acts and deeds whereby the Lawyer was authorised to withdraw the case also.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any valid reason to entertain this petition.

The petition is dismissed.
