ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL):

Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.26 dated 22.03.2019 under Sections 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Lakhewali, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged recovery from the petitioner admittedly does not fall in commercial category. He further submits that the petitioner is in custody for 03 months and 25 days. The petitioner is not involved in any other case. Investigation has been completed and the challan has been presented.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate in the Court today and the same is taken on record. Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid factual position.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody for more than three months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, therefore the petitioner is

directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
