RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J (ORAL)

1. Heard counsel for final disposal.
2. They are ad idem that this petition can be disposed of with one of the directions issued today in accompanying CWP No.22751 of 2017 vide separate order of even date. The difference between this and the other petitions is that the provisional No Objection Certificate has been granted in this case by Punjab Agro Food Grains Corporation to the petitioner-miller and only the necessary formalities have to be completed subject to eligibility as per the terms of the Custom Milling Policy 2019-20. Ms. Deepali Puri submits that the case of the petitioner-miller was put up for consideration but there were some complications discovered with regard to

certain eligibility conditions as per the policy which the miller has to fulfill.

The petitioners will come forward to help in complying with the deficiencies and satisfying the conditions precedent to allotment of paddy for milling, as are pointed out to them. On completion of formalities within 10 days, the paddy will be allotted to the miller expeditiously.
