CRM-M-2550 of 2018 was disposed of on 22.1.2018 with the direction to Director General of Police (Crime), Haryana to look into the grievance of the petitioner after providing an opportunity of hearing and take action as per law.

Reply dated 17.9.2019 by way of affidavit of Prashanta Kumar Agrawal, Director General of Police, Crime, Haryana filed in court is taken on record, copy already supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

With the reply, order dated 22.8.2019 has been annexed wherein the Director General of Police, Crime, Haryana after looking into the representation has come to the conclusion that no cognizable offence is made out as the dispute is civil in nature.

In view of the reply filed, no further orders are called for in the

present contempt petition. The same is disposed of as infructuous. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order dated 22.8.2019.
