Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of order dated 18.04.2019 (Annexure P-6) whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed person in complaint under Section 156(3) of Cr.P.C. to lodge an FIR under Sections 498-A, 406, 320, 321, 323, 377 and 497 of IPC.

Vide order dated 19.10.2019, the present case was ordered to be listed for rehearing on 30.10.2019.

Vide order dated 13.03.2019, the learned Magistrate, Panchkula had issued proclamation under Section 82 Cr.P.C. against the petitioner after recording the statement of the executing official to the effect that proclamation has been effected and the case was adjourned for 18.04.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that on 19.10.2019 when the petition was listed before this Court, he could not

produce the order dated 13.03.2019 passed by the court below. He states that in fact he produced order dated 04.02.2019 taking it to be as order dated 13.03.2019. He further states that the petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court in the matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and his wife Roop Kaur @ Ramanjot Kaur @ Nishu. He further states that the respondent is otherwise remarried.

The explanation submitted by the petitioner be read in the continuity of the order dated 19.10.2019 and in case the petitioner appears before the trial Court within one month from today and gives an undertaking to face trial in accordance with law, he shall be admitted on interim bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court, however, that would be subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited with the High Court Bar Association in the Lawyers' Welfare Fund.
