Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.317 dated 11.09.2018 registered under Sections 186, 332, 353, 452, 506, 307, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Section 68 of the Excise Act, at Police Station Sadar Jind, District Jind.

As per the case of the prosecution, two boys including the petitioner scaled the wall and tried to forcibly enter the office of Vice-Chancellor. When security personnel tried to stop them, they manhandled and one of them fired with his pistol directly towards employee but fortunately no injury was caused.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that co-accused Sunil has already been released on bail vide order dated 20.05.2019 passed in CRM-M-16853 of 2019. He further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 11.09.2018. He further submits that the prosecution has

examined Dharambir/PW-1, Bijender PW-2 and Dilbagh Singh/PW-3 who have not supported the case of the prosecution.

On the other hand, learned State counsel opposed the bail application on the ground that there was an attempt to murder.

Since trial is pending, therefore, it would not be appropriate for this Court to make any observation on the merits of the case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
