Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.169 dated 01.07.2019 under Sections 324, 452, 323, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 22.07.2019: -

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is an old person aged about 56 years. It is further submitted that the main accused namely Nirmal Singh, who is son of the petitioner has already surrendered before the trial Court. It is also submitted that there are no specific allegations against the petitioner.

Counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner be

directed to join the investigation....”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jeet Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 22.07.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
