The present revision has been filed against the order dated 17.05.2019 (Annexure P-3) whereby evidence of the petitioner has been closed. The petitioner has filed a divorce petition (Annexure P-1) in the year 2016 and issues were framed on 10.11.2017 as is evident from the impugned order and since then the case was pending for the evidence of the petitioner. Two witnesses by the names of Lakhwinder Singh and Jaspal Singh, the affidavits of these two witnesses were already placed on record, were summoned for 17.05.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that these two witnesses were part of the panchayat proceedings and could not appear to depose on 17.05.2019 in the matrimonial dispute of the petitioner. They are essential witnesses and the learned counsel on the specific query states that the evidence of the respondent is going on and has not been concluded. The next date before the trial Court is 25.07.2019.

Revision is allowed and order dated 17.05.2019 is being set aside with further direction to the trial Court to give one effective

opportunity to examine these two witnesses Lakhwinder Singh and Jaspal Singh subject to payment of Rs.3,000/- as costs to be deposited with District Legal Services Authority, Kapurthala.
