Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.31 dated 03.02.2019 registered under Sections 21/22/25/27(a)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.

As per the case of the prosecution, 5 intoxicating injections were recovered.

As per Investigating Officer namely ASI Avtar Singh, who is present in the Court, investigations have been completed and as per his information, petitioner is not involved in any other case under NDPS Act.

Quantity recovered is normally for self-consumption.

Petitioner is in custody since 03.02.2019.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the abovesaid facts, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
